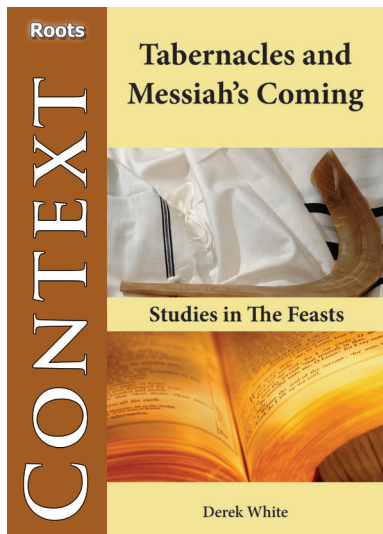

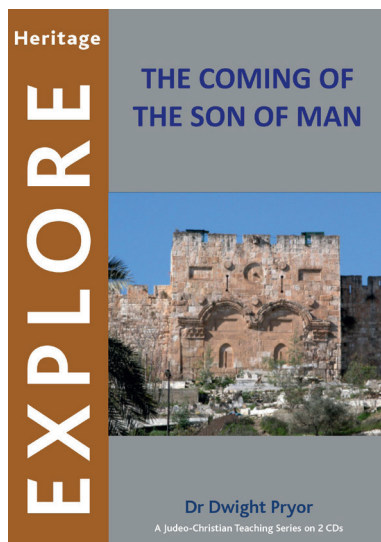
CDS66 - The Coming of the Son of Man

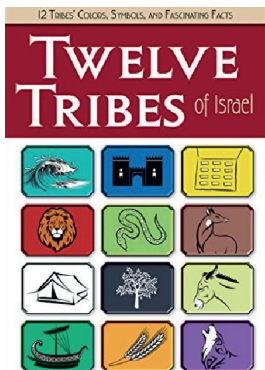

The children of Israel belonged to one of twelve tribes based on their ancestry. Every tribe had its own history, land and heritage, and each was given a particular blessing or prophecy.

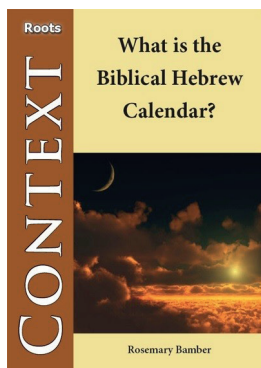
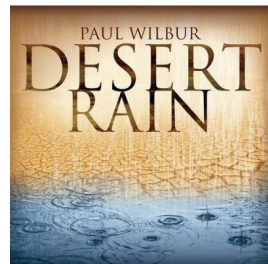
This 14-panel foldout pamphlet presents the cultural and historical background of these tribes, along with a map and a timeline of key events.
